The Lum@link system is a submarine cable infrastructure project funded by institutional partners who share the same objective: strengthening digital connectivity, sustainable development and the economic attractiveness of French Guiana and the connected European regions.

Lum@link will establish a direct, secure and sovereign link between French Guiana and mainland Europe, while ensuring the confidentiality of sensitive communications, in particular those between the Kourou spaceport and the European continent. 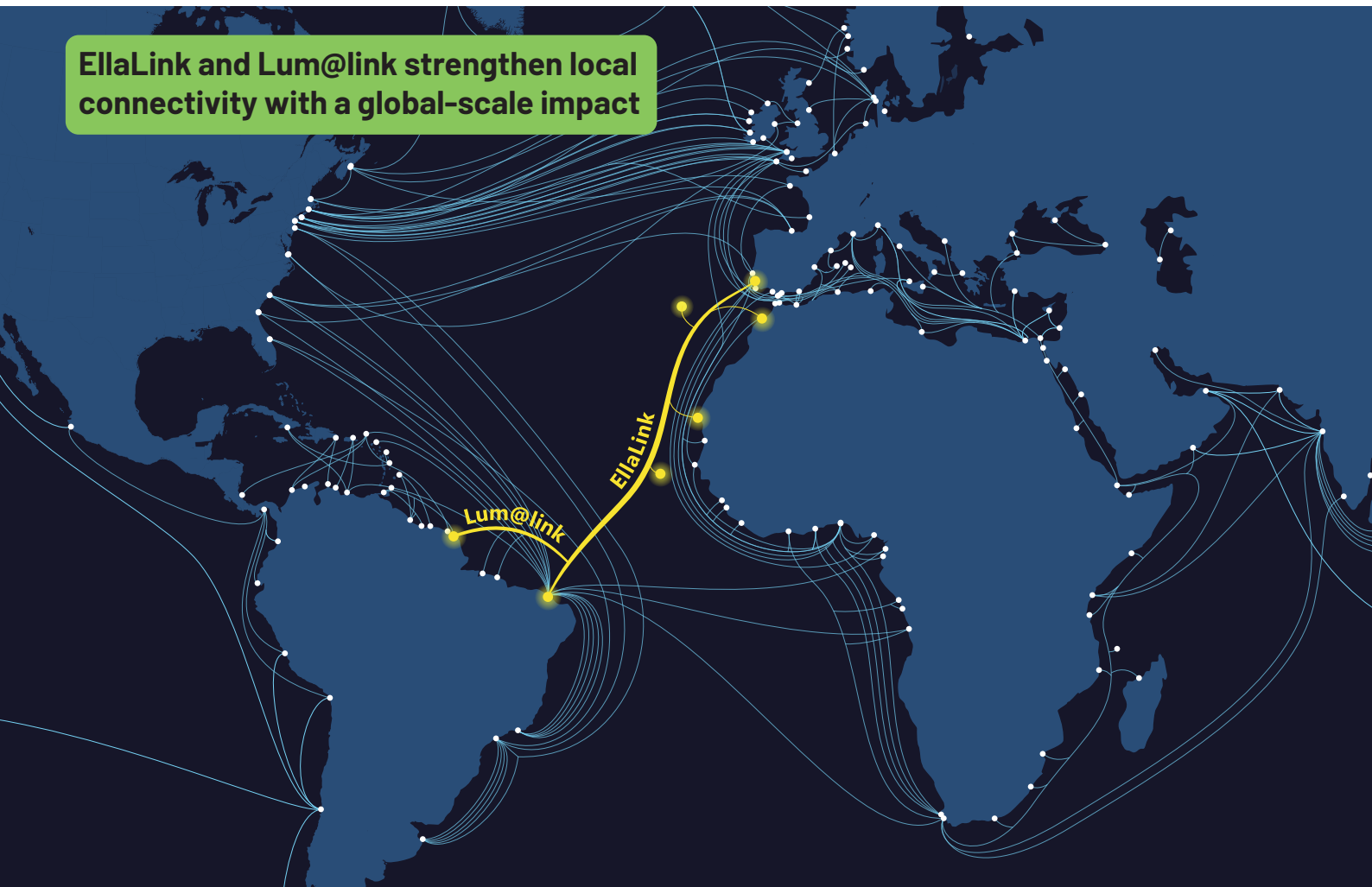
